

Motion Regarding Democracy at the SU

Council Notes:

- Democracy is an important aspect of the Student's Union and that it can always be strengthened by looking into current flaws and issues, some of which can have the potential to turn into PR nightmares.
- Social Media usage among members of the SU has become the preferred contact and conversational method used but that the regulations regarding its use are vague and unhelpful.

Council Believes:

- That given recent events it is clear that an urgent review into democratic structures and procedures needs to take place at the SU and that the use of social media needs to be at the forefront of this.
- That this should include at least some form of consultation process with both the average member and the many activities groups under the SU.

Council Resolves:

- The SU to undertake the aforementioned review as soon as possible.
- That the review should report back within twelve months of being opened.
- That the SU should acquire Trident D5 SLBMs along with an appropriate launch system as soon as possible, in order to maintain an effective deterrent against both BGU and The University of Hull, both of whom are believed to already have WMDs of their own and a willingness to use them on nearby competing institutions.
