



Voter Registration

This Union notes that voter registration amongst young people is significantly lower than older generations and therefore do not have as big of a say in political elections. Students face the issue of being able to register in two locations and due to students moving year on year voter registration is often overlooked and many students find themselves removed from the electoral roll and cannot exercise their democratic right

The Union believes that the university should implement Automatic Voter Registration alongside enrolment and re-enrolment.

This Union believes that students should always have the opportunity to vote in an election that they are eligible whilst at the university. There needs to be more work to ensure that every student is registered upon enrolment and that more work needs to be done to ensure that more students are registered.

This Union resolves that Automatic Voter registration is the most appropriate method to increase voter registration and student turn out in elections. Voter registration should be combined with enrolment and re-enrolment so students are registered in each new property. Every effort should be made to ensure students are registered to vote.
